

## CTF Board Outcomes Discussion

1. Purpose
  - a. To determine what the Board is interested in measuring related to CTF grantees implementation
  - b. Create a plan for collecting data from Cohort 29 moving forward
2. Data already collected
  - a. How many? - Grantees set goals about numbers served and TA staff monitor. Data gathered from the grantees and the OCDEL Database
  - b. Who is being served? - Grantees enter demographic data into the OCDEL database.
  - c. What are assessments saying about impact? – Grantees asked about trends in site visits and outcomes reports – specific data not collected about model tools.
  - d. For some grantees – performance measures if they are an evidence-based home visiting program
3. The Challenge
  - a. Different programs
  - b. Families already completing many assessments
4. Outcomes Collected
  - a. In the past grantees have been asked to complete a singular tool related to Strengthening Families Protective Factors.
    - i. Examples:
      1. A 10 question tool adapted from the Protective Factors Survey - not validated
      2. Parents Assessment of Protective Factors – validated tool
    - ii. Grantee feedback at the time – difficult to administer another assessment
  - b. Cohorts 27 and 28 were asked to track the same outcomes related to the Strengthening Families Protective Factors, but could choose how they would assess.
    - i. Thought process – they could match tools already using to outcomes
    - ii. Reality
      1. Not all were using tools that measured the outcomes.
      2. In some cases grantees created tools to match or added questions to existing tools.
      3. Often using a single question from a tool or a construct (not the full validated tool)
  - c. Cohorts 29 and the RFA just received
    - i. Created logic models
    - ii. Chose 4 outcomes with associated measurement tools
5. Moving Forward
  - a. What does the Board want to know about CTF Grantees and the families they serve?
    - i. We can provide demographic data and the number of families served
    - ii. What kind of impact data might you want to know?
      1. Individual level data – As a result of this program this caregiver...
      2. Organizational level data – As a result of CTF funds...
      3. Satisfaction data – Parents and caregivers provide this feedback...
    - iii. Is there a particular data point of interest?
      1. Growth in protective factors
      2. Change in stress level
      3. Increase in resilience
      4. Parent self-efficacy
      5. Something else?
